Will summary – 1745 John Fleming, Earl of Wigtown

- Signed 25 Jan 1742
- Died 10 Feb 1744 at Cumbernauld in the parish of Easter Lenzie
- Given from his own mouth
- Partly made and given up by William Maule Earl of Panmure
- Witnessed by Executors William Maule Earl of Panmure, John Maull of Juneskeiller and William Fleming of Barochan.
- Desponed in favour of
 - William Earl of Panmure
 - John Maull
 - Thomas Drummond of Logie Almond
 - Alexander Lockart, Advocate
 - William Fleming of Barochan
- Inventory
 - Gold, silver, banknotes in a cabinet – 164/4/6
 - In a cabinet at Cumbernauld – 18 crown pieces; a guinea; 5/7/-
 - House cows, horses etc
 - Total goods and chattels = 2001/6/- Scots money.
- Money owed to him
 - 1000 merks Scots – bond by William Fleming of Barochan on 19/11/1724
 - 182/11/4 Scots = 25 year's interest on the above
- Total estate =
- Probate 23/1/1745 witnessed by
 - John Wardlaw, factor to the late Earl of Wigtown
 - Alexander Day, schoolmaster at Cumbernauld
